

Checklist for transferring colleges

Planning & applying

	Research colleges and make a list of schools you're interested in. Talk to your uAspire advisor about affordable options
	Meet with an academic advisor at least once per term to develop your transfer plan and make sure you're taking the right classes
	Also consider meeting with transfer counselors at your current college & the new colleges' admissions staff
	Research application requirements and deadlines, as well as financial aid deadlines
	Complete your admissions applications & financial aid applications by the priority deadlines
	Check your federal financial aid lifetime eligibility at studentaid.gov

	Submit your high school and/or college transcript to the new college
	If transferring during an academic term, complete any necessary withdrawal paperwork from your previous college
	Pay any remaining charges to your previous college. Talk with your uAspire advisor if you're having trouble paying the bill
	Attend in-person or complete online orientation, if required
	Complete any required placement tests
	Meet with an academic advisor to register for classes
	If applicable, waive school health insurance if you already have coverage
