

Checklist for transferring colleges

Planning & applying

- Research colleges and make a list of schools you're interested in. Talk to your uAspire advisor about affordable options
- Meet with an academic advisor at least once per term to develop your transfer plan and make sure you're taking the right classes
- Also consider meeting with transfer counselors at your current college & the new colleges' admissions staff
- Research application requirements and deadlines, as well as financial aid deadlines
- Complete your admissions applications & financial aid applications by the priority deadlines
- Check your federal financial aid lifetime eligibility at studentaid.gov

Preparing to enroll

- Submit your high school and/or college transcript to the new college
- If transferring during an academic term, complete any necessary withdrawal paperwork from your previous college
- Pay any remaining charges to your previous college. Talk with your uAspire advisor if you're having trouble paying the bill
- Attend in-person or complete online orientation, if required
- Complete any required placement tests
- Meet with an academic advisor to register for classes
- If applicable, waive school health insurance if you already have coverage
- Review options to pay your fall bill. Make sure to prepare for other expenses you may also have, like books and school supplies
